Adelaide Hills (65%) / Tasmania (35%)

COLOUR

At release, the wine is a delicate light cherry red colour with brilliant clarity.

NOSE

The wine is highly scented with a perfume of fresh strawberry and subtle confectionery with underlying delicate herbal lavender notes and french oak.

PALATE

This is a light to medium-bodied wine with a delicate texture. On the palate, there are delicious blackcurrant flavours with hints of spice from French oak. Overall, the palate is well-rounded, fresh, and showcases great varietal character upon release

OAK MATURATION

The wine was matured in premium old French oak barrels - so as not to overpower the delicacy of the fruit - for 8 months before being bottled.

CELLARING NOTES

Crafted for immediate enjoyment but will cellar over a medium term under ideal conditions.
