REGION

Clare Valley (62.5%) / Limestone Coast (37.5%)

COLOUR

At release, the wine is a dark red colour with ruby red hues.

NOSE

The wine has a wonderful aroma displaying dark plum, redcurrant and red cherry fruits along with subtle chocolate and a touch of oak derived spice.

PALATE

The palate is plump & generous with ripe fruit characters of plum, cherry and redcurrant. Mocha coffee and subtle aniseed characters are also present along with vanillin oak to balance the fruit flavours. The wine is medium-bodied with a soft mid-palate & pleasing tannin structure. It is a well balanced wine with great texture, good length and enjoyable fruit flavours on the finish.

OAK MATURATION

The wine was matured in American oak for 12 months followed by fining, minimal filtration & bottling.

CELLARING NOTES

Crafted for immediate enjoyment but will cellar over a medium term under ideal conditions.
